- 3. Warm the dressing between your hands
- **4.** Peel the 'top' white release paper off and gently apply the centre part of the dressing
- **5.** Remove the 'bottom' white release paper while rolling the dressing into place, without stretching
- 6. Remove the clear white release paper on the other side
- **7.** Carry out this process on your **forehead**, **nose and cheeks**, molding the dressing into place for 30-60 seconds.

Painless removal

- **1.** Press down on the skin with one hand and carefully lift an edge of the dressing with your other hand.
- 2. Stretch the dressing downwards away from the skin to break the adhesive seal and remove. If necessary, use an adhesive remover, such as Sensi-Care® Adhesive Remover Wipes, to aid dressing removal.
