

Application Guidelines^{*}

Sacral



Assess the area to protect. Before applying the dressing, cleanse the area with an appropriate cleanser and dry the skin.



Remove the central release liner first. Hold the dressing at its edges. Fold the dressing in half, with the back sides touching. Place the fold into the natal cleft.



Keep the center pad in contact with the sacral area and smooth the edges of the dressing into place.





Suggestions for facility guidelines for skin protection

- Apply only to intact, clean dry skin on the sacrum/coccyx area
- Apply to patients with a Braden scale of 18 or below and if the patient CANNOT reposition themselves
- Sensi-Care[®] Sting Free Skin Barrier Use on skin prior to applying dressing in areas where adherence may be challenging or perspiration is an issue
- Inspect underneath dressing daily and document skin condition
- Change dressing according to hospital policy (**7 day** max wear time) or when stool or urine gets underneath the dressing
- Initial and date the dressing upon application
- Consult WOC/Wound Care Nurse if pressure ulcer development is suspected

FOR EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT ONLY:

• Apply if patient is admitted, but will be held in the ED for more than 4 hours and cannot relieve pressure to sacrum when on stretcher

FOR OPERATING ROOM ONLY:

Apply to sacrum or other at risk areas for procedures lasting 4 hours or more
