Attach the precisely labeled Flexi-Seal® FMS syringe to the white inflation port with the Signal fill indicator (marked 45 mL), and pull back the plunger to remove all excess air from the balloon.

Fill the empty syringe to inflate the retention balloon with 45 mL of tap water or saline.

The balloon should never be inflated with more than 45 mL of fluid.



Slowly depress the syringe plunger.



The Signal indicator has an oval inflation chamber, or bubble, that will expand as fluid is injected. Once the balloon has reached the optimal fill level, the indicator bubble will pop.



Once the Signal indicator bubble has popped, a "best practice" approach is to pull back the syringe plunger to deflate the bubble, and then reinflate it just to the point of popping. This ensures the balloon is filled to the appropriate volume (up to 45 mL) to prevent overinflation.
